Playing Up a Division Policy

This policy allows players to evaluate for the age group above their appropriate Division provided they meet the following requirements.

- 1. The player must be entering their second year in the appropriate Division.
- 2. The player must rank in the top five of players evaluated for their appropriate Division.
- 3. The Player Agent Committee must agree that the player is ready to move up based on conversations with references provided. Readiness will be based on the player's level of maturity, leadership and knowledge of the game. Please provide the contact information for the player's most recent baseball coach:

If all of the above criteria is met, the player would be offered the opportunity to evaluate for the older Division. The player must then rank in the top 80% of the evaluated players deemed eligible to be drafted in the AAA Division. The player will not be able to play in AA in the higher age Division.
